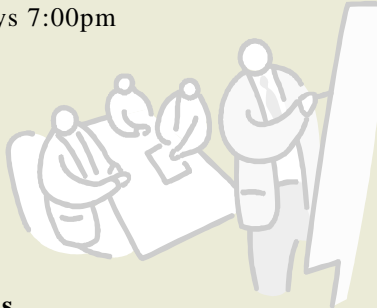

Mission Statement

Our mission is to provide alcohol and drug treatment services to any resident regardless of race, color, age, sex, national origin, disability, religion, or ability to pay. We are dedicated to providing these services with the highest regard to the well being and dignity of each client.

Confidentiality

All contacts with this agency are protected by Federal Regulations of Confidentiality, 42 CFR, Part 2. Phone calls can be anonymous. No verbal or written information will be given without the client's permission.

Fees

The cost of services is often covered by health insurance. Fees are based on a sliding fee scale, determined by family size and income. No person will be refused care due to a documented inability to pay.

Services Available To You

The Turning Point offers many services to help you turn your life around. Our agency offers Assessments, Treatment, Referrals, Family Counseling, Gender, age or issue specific services, Learning Life Lessons (program for adolescents), Prevention and Drug Screens. Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous Meetings are also held at our agency.

Procedure For Receiving Treatment

If you are interested in treatment at our agency please call or stop in. We will ask a few initial questions and then schedule a time for you to come in and fill out the paperwork. After the paperwork is completed we will schedule a time for your assessment. Your assessment will provide our clinical staff with a comprehensive view of your assessed needs and will discuss with you our recommendations for your treatment.

Prevention

The Turning Point provides prevention classes for all schools in Paulding County. These classes consist of prevention education on alcohol, marijuana, tobacco, self-esteem, assertiveness, ways to say no, peer pressure and many other helpful topics for grades 3-9. If you work in a Paulding County school and are interested in scheduling prevention classes please contact Destri Long. Mrs. Long is also a HUGS instructor. Help Us Grow Safely (HUGS) is a community based training that teaches how to safely and effectively intervene in negative adult/child interactions in an effort to prevent child maltreatment. If you would like to learn more about this service please contact Mrs. Long.

Another aspect of our prevention programming is our "Spirit of a Young Woman Camp." This camp is specific to Paulding County teenage girls ages 12-15. This is a five day residential camp that is a learning experience as well as a fun time and an opportunity to meet other girls from around the county. At this camp, girls will learn about topics such as self-esteem, depression, healthy eating, alcohol, drugs, stereotypes, cliques, communication and many other topics that teenage girls encounter in their daily lives.

This camp is held every June. For more information or to sign your daughter up for camp contact Chelsea Mansfield.

Drug Screens

Our agency contracts with local employers to ensure that their facility is a safe environment. The employers send us potential employees to test before they are hired and random employees to test periodically throughout the month. We also perform drug tests for Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and the court systems.
